

JDU Financial Policy

Jesus Disciple University is committed to keeping training accessible and financially transparent. This policy describes tuition, payment terms, and financial expectations for JDU students.

Tuition

Each JDU program has its own tuition, which is published on the program's registration page. Tuition for the inaugural Disciplemaker's Certificate cohort (Fall 2026) is:

- **Non-Degree Track:** \$495
- **Degree Track:** \$995

Tuition is an all-in cost that covers the full two-semester program (Fall 2026 through Spring 2027). There are no additional per-course, per-semester, or activity fees.

Payment terms

- **Payment is due in full at enrollment.** Enrollment is not complete until payment is received.
- **Accepted payment methods:** all major credit and debit cards, processed securely through Stripe.
- **Receipt:** an automated receipt is emailed to the address you provide at payment.
- **The entity of record** on your credit card statement will appear as JESUS DISCIPLE UNIV.

Payment plans

JDU does not currently offer installment payment plans for the inaugural Fall 2026 cohort. Payment plan availability may be added for future cohorts.

Non-payment

Registration is not confirmed until payment is received. Students whose payment fails or is reversed after enrollment will be contacted and given ten (10) business days to resolve the payment before being removed from the cohort.

Refunds

Refunds are governed by JDU's Withdrawal and Refund Policy. See that policy for the full refund schedule and hardship exceptions.

Tax

JDU tuition may or may not be tax-deductible depending on your personal tax situation. JDU does not provide tax advice — consult your tax advisor for questions about your specific circumstances.
